**Liberation:** education is to be liberating; it can so easily be disabling and oppressive.

Liberation is a by-product of the way in which the experience Participants bring with them is

used, the experience gained from their placements and the participative style of the Course. Participants often speak about being given confidence to be themselves rather than someone they believe a tradition or a group expects them to be. Liberation shows itself particularly in the work handed in for assessment.

There are no examinations and there is a wide range of choices to be made by Participants. Assessment work reaches high academic standards of research and creative expression and reflects Participant's interests, personal growth and personal awareness.
